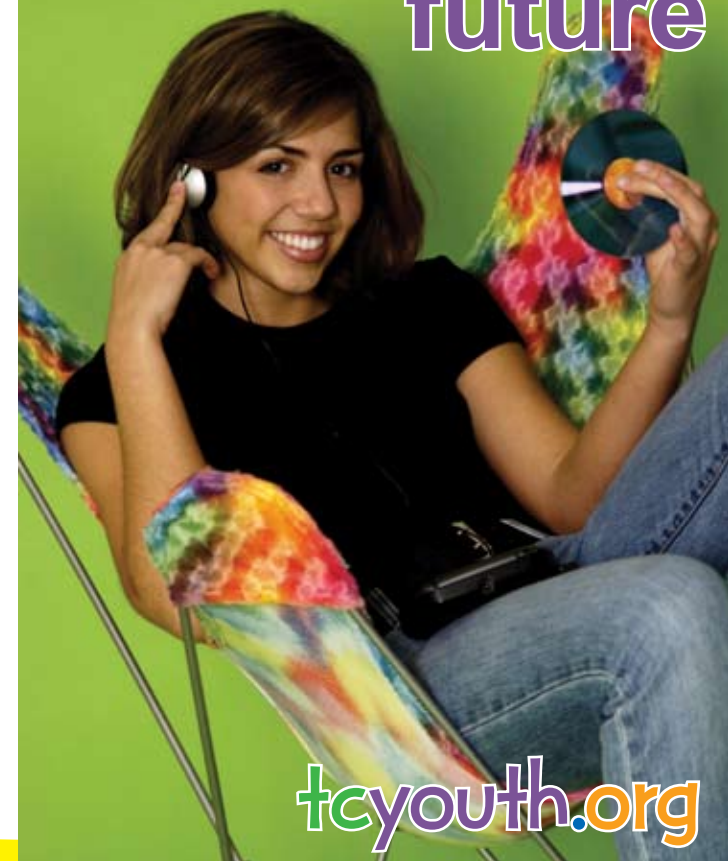

career academies

Did you know that there are special career academies inside your high school? Career academies are two-, three-, and four-year programs that let students learn about a certain career field, like healthcare. Students volunteer to enter the academy, but they have to apply and be accepted with the support of their parent or guardian.

Different teachers from different subjects work together and students are grouped together for several periods every day with a core group of teachers. The curriculum helps prepare high school students for college or technical school and helps them on their career path.
